Thank you for an opportunity to present my mid-cycle goals update. The pandemic forced attention away from my 12/5/2019 approved goals, but there has been forward movement in many areas. I welcome your feedback on the status of these goals and any other way I can improve in leading the district. As you know, these goals are aligned with our strategic plan "Medfield 2021".

Student Learning

1. Goal #2 - Strategy 1.1.3

Collaborate with the School Committee, Administration, Staff and Community to move forward SEL indicatives district wide. Focus on reducing the number of students self-reporting issues of mental health and substance abuse on the MetroWest Adolescent Health Survey, as well as data from SOS and Interface.

- SEL Task Force Key topic include Staff Wellness, Parent Engagement, School Start Time, School Schedule, Student Wellness, and SEL Curriculum
- Member of Challenge Success
- Medfield Talks Speakers

- Approved the administration of the MCAP Student Surveys

2. Goal #5 - Strategy 4.1.1 and 4.1.2

Work on all aspects of the Dale Street Project including: secure project funds, active member of School Building Committee, management of communications with the OPM, Architect, and construction, and meeting all of the MSBA timelines.

3. Goal #1 - Strategy 4.1.1

Pilot two elementary classrooms focused on project based learning. Provide teachers and principal support with training, planning time and budget.

- Identified the pilot school and held several meetings with Principal, Steve Grenham
- Identified two teachers to conduct the pilot for the 2020-2021 school year
- Scheduled teacher training for Spring 2020; cancelled due to pandemic
- The plan is to try again in the 2021-2022 school year

4. Goal #2 - Strategy 4.1.1

Collaborate with the Leadership Team to expand cultural proficiency in classrooms and curricula in grades Pre-K-12.

- Civil Rights Self- Evaluation Committee
 - o Year One: January April 2019
 - o Year Two: December 2019 February 2020
 - Year Three December: 2020 February 2021
- Medfield Model for Evaluation of Bias in Content in Instructional Materials
 - o All staff trained in Spring of 2019
 - o Shared with the Director on Instruction and Innovation in Fall of 2020
 - O Used to support roll out of new curriculum for Civics
- Book Groups Anti-Racism
 - Book groups focused on race started at Blake in the 2018-2019 School Year
 - o Moved to district wide book groups in the summer of 2020
- Support MERJ (Medfield Educators for Racial Justice)
 - District wide book group discussed creating a district wide group to focus on discussions around race
 - o Meet at the building level on own
 - Meet monthly, in the evenings, as a full district group
- District wide discussion groups as PD in September of 2020
 - o Broke into 20 small groups facilitated by members of MERJ
 - Used videos and Hometown Weekly article to lead discussion on race and impact on education in general as well as in Medfield specifically
 - Every group created a padlet to highlight themes, questions, next steps and actions
 - Plan to use these questions, next steps and actions to build on PD within district moving forward
- Native Americans Consultant to work with Elementary Teachers
- Cultural Proficiency professional development for leadership team at annual retreat (postponed)

Plan for and complete a new strategic plan process that will result in a five year strategic plan for the district

- Continue to partner with Beginning Years to establish a daycare for the children of teachers and staff
- Held monthly meetings with MCPE co-presidents and attended their board meetings
- Continued the work of "Medfield Talks"
- Served on the ACCEPT and TEC Board of Directors
- Co-President of the Tri County Superintendents Roundtable
- Appointed the Massachusetts Association of School Superintendents Executive Committee
- MASS representative on the MIAA Statewide Football Committee
