Please submit to the Counseling Office <u>no later than</u> **February 4, 2020.**

# Where does TAB meet?

TAB meetings are normally held in the Community Room located next to the Children's Room at the Metuchen Public Library. Snacks and drinks are provided!

Note: Since the library closed to the public in March 2020 as a response to the COVID-19 pandemic, TAB meetings have been held virtually online via Zoom.

# How do I join TAB?

You can join TAB by attending one of our meetings and submitting your application form. At your first TAB meeting, you will learn more about volunteer opportunities offered through the library and more about the teen advisory board. You will earn one hour of community service for each TAB meeting you attend.

# Do I need to get approved?

Yes. Once you submit your application, you will receive an email as confirmation that you have been approved.

# What does TAB do?

As a member of TAB, you will take an active role in how the Young Adult Department operates. You will help plan programs and events for children and teens, participate in creative activities, strategize about community outreach, contribute ideas for new projects, give feedback about the library's collection, and have an important role in making decisions in all things concerning the library's Young Adult Department. Most TAB meetings are dedicated to discussing youth services programs and how you can participate in planning them.

Volunteer opportunities through TAB include assisting with library programs for children, teens, and adults - as well as other events as needed. To volunteer at one of these library events, we send a sign-up sheet through email so that you may register based on your interest and availability. Your attendance is required to do certain events which are detailed on the application.

Note: As a result of the library's closure due to COVID-19, all in-person library programs have been canceled until further notice.

# What about Virtual Volunteering?

While the library has been closed for the pandemic, Metuchen Public Library has offered virtual volunteering opportunities for current TAB members. These opportunities range from writing book reviews, recording story time videos, submitting writing and photos, and many more opportunities!
