



## **2019 Scholarship Guidelines and Application**

Following are answers to common questions about the Golden West Telecommunications' Scholarship Program, the merit-based scholarship awards for senior high school students.

### **Who is Eligible?**

1. **The student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must reside within one of the Golden West telephone service areas (see list) and subscribe to a Golden West service (phone, internet and/or cable tv).**
2. The applicant must be a high school senior.
3. Applicants must take the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT), American College Test (ACT) or the Accuplacer Vocation Entrance Exam at an examination center of their choice no later than December 31 of their senior year.
4. Scholarship awards may only be applied to accredited post-secondary institutions.
5. The recipient of the award must begin attending a post-secondary institution, complete a full-time course load (as defined by the institution's credit policy) the fall semester immediately following graduation from high school in order to be eligible for the scholarship. The student must also provide proof of enrollment in a full-time course load for the second semester.

### **How Many Scholarships Will You Award, and Whom Will I Compete Against?**

Scholarship awards will be one-time, \$1,000 scholarships. The Golden West Telecommunications' Scholarship Program will offer a total of 45 awards. Each high school will be eligible to receive one award.

Eligible applicants will compete against other eligible applicants from their high school.

### **Who Will Select the Scholarship Award Winners?**

The Selection Committee shall consist of the high school's principal, guidance counselor and/or superintendent, who are not connected with the Golden West Telecommunications' Scholarship Program. The Selection Committee will be responsible for the confidential review of each applicant's file. They alone will determine the scholarship award winners.

### **How Will Applications Be Judged?**

The Selection Committee will judge applicants' scholarship and leadership abilities based on the following information.

1. SAT, ACT, or Accuplacer scores
2. Transcript of high school credits
3. Scholarship Application

This is a merit-based scholarship program. Merit includes leadership in school, civic and other extracurricular activities; academic achievement; and the motivation to serve and succeed. Personal character is also very important.

If two or more applications are extremely close in qualifications, the selection panel is asked to use financial need as the tiebreaker.



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### **How Do I Apply, and What Are the Deadlines?**

Students who are interested in competing for a Golden West Scholarship Award should obtain a Scholarship Application from their local high school guidance office. The Scholarship Application, along with an up-to-date transcript and SAT, ACT, or Accuplacer score results, should be submitted to the local high school Principal or Superintendent, or designated school official.

**Applications for 2019 graduates must be completed and returned to the designated school official by March 15, 2019. DO NOT send the application directly to Golden West.**

### **How Will the Awards Be Administered?**

Award winners will be announced at the respective graduation exercises attended by the winners, and also will be published in the Golden West newsletter. Golden West requests a photo of each winner for publication in the newsletter.

The award becomes final when the student has completed the equivalent of a full-time course load in their first semester of their freshman year and enrolls in the second semester at an accredited post-secondary institution. All checks are paid directly to the school; under no circumstance will we make payment directly to the student.

The scholarship monies may be used for tuition, fees, books and supplies. In order to receive payment, a student must arrange for the school send to our Wall office a completed Verification of Enrollment form, whereupon we will issue our check, payable to the school, and mail it directly to the school to establish a credit in the name of the student. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that their school send the Verification of Enrollment to Golden West.

If a student terminates his or her course for any reason, the unused balance of the scholarship **MUST** be returned directly to the Golden West Telecommunications' Scholarship Program. It may **NOT** be transferred to another school (after disbursement) and it may **NOT** be paid to the student personally.

In our scholarship program, it is the responsibility of the student to follow up on all matters relating to his or her scholarship. In all correspondence relating to a student who has won, or is applying for, a scholarship award, we must have the full name of the student.
