Once again it is time to seek outstanding high school seniors to apply for the second largest scholarship program in the nation; The Elks "Most Valuable Student Scholarship Award Program".





1. Applicants must be enrolled or planning to enroll in an accredited post-secondary technical or vocational program which terminates with completion of that program. Applicants shall have no immediate or long range plans to pursue a baccalaureate degree program.

<u>PLEASE NCTE</u>: If your plans change and you enroll in a 4 year college, you become ineligible for the grant and must contact your local Elks Lodge immediately.

- 2. All scholarship are in the form of certificates of award issued by the State Office conditioned upon the enrollment of the student in a technical degree program in an accredited American post-secondary school. Upon receipt of a verification of enrollment from proper school officials, a South Dakota Elks Association check in the amount of the award (\$1,000.00) will be forwarded to the post-secondary school to establish credit for the student.
