

ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION

In accordance with the Federal EPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), all public and private K-12 schools in the United States are required to inspect their facilities for asbestos. An additional requirement of the regulations is that parents and staff are to be informed that the inspection was done. Copenhagen Central School's facilities have been inspected for both friable (crumbles easily) and non-friable materials which contain asbestos. All friable asbestos has been removed from the District's buildings. Non-friable asbestos materials were found in various areas in the buildings. These areas are both accessible and inaccessible to the students and staff members. The situation does not pose a health risk at this time and we are carrying on periodic inspections in ensure that there is no release of asbestos fibers. The record of inspection, drawings showing the locations of the friable and non-friable materials and a copy of the management plan are secured by the District Office and available for your inspection.
