## Junction City School District/NECC Procedures For Homeless Children/Youth Or Unaccompanied Youth

- Junction City Schools will post homeless children/youth rights poster throughout the campus.
- Junction City Schools will pass out brochures to students as they enroll.
- Junction City Schools will send home a letter with all students asking for people to notify the school of any suspected homeless children/youth.
- Junction City Schools will post homeless children/youth Rights in the community.
- The staff will receive a list of the warning signs to look for in identifying homelessness.
- Junction City Schools will enroll any student suspected to be homeless without delay.
- The student will be allowed in school while being assisted with the documentation problem.
- Our school will accept alternative documents as specified by the law.
- Our school will assist the child/youth in getting need immunizations.
- The homeless liaison will be notified by the staff if a student is suspected of being homeless.
- The student will receive free breakfast and lunch.
- The student will be assessed for any other needs both personally and educationally.
