

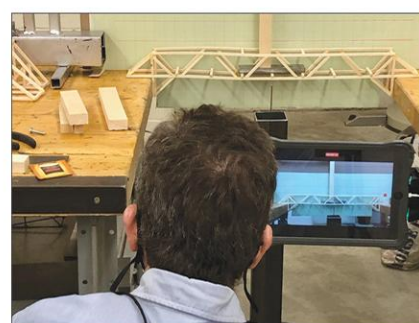
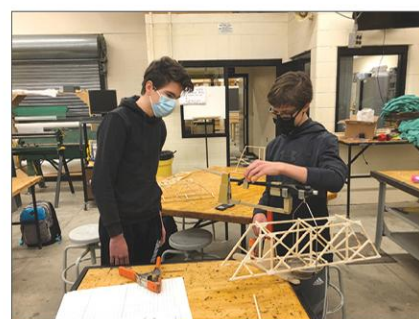

Technology Education Teacher

As part of our investigation of Structures and the forces acting on them, these Engineering Design students have designed and built trusses. The design criteria were established, and materials sent home. These projects were all constructed at home then brought back to school for testing. As each student applied more and more force to the bridge, slow-motion video revealed the points of maximum stress and strain and the severity and instantaneous nature of structural failure. Five designs achieved strength to weight ratios were above 400:1, Jake Jones, Tyler Anderson, Isaac Franklin. First runner up: Alec Flotten with a score of 539:1. Bragging rights and top dawg status go to Mason Thom whose truss managed to support and distribute 186 lbs. Mason's final strength/weight ratio of 625:1 crushed the competition. Great job everyone!

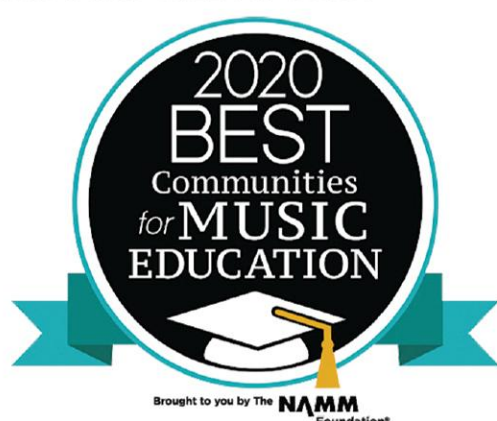
