SIoux VALLEY SENIOR PRIVILEGES GUIDELINES
(Tentative Start Date is 1/20/21)

1. To be eligible, seniors must have earned at least a 'B' in every class for the first semester of the 2020-2021 school year except Pre-Calculus, Physics, Anatomy, or dual credit courses where a 'C' is acceptable. Once privileges begin, students must maintain a weekly 'B' average in each course and a 'C' in the courses specified above. Seniors will lose their privileges because of a deficient grade. Senior privileges can be earned back once students' grades achieve the above criteria. **Senior privileges begin on Monday of each week.**
2. Grades will be checked each Thursday for the following week of senior privileges. Seniors should double check for the 'SP' on their weekly attendance in Infinite Campus. **Seniors failing to check their eligibility and continuing to use senior privileges will result in the consequences listed under number five below.**
3. Qualifying seniors in study hall do not have to check in as 'SP' will be already be recorded on your attendance.
4. Seniors may not loiter in the hallways, gym, locker rooms, PAC, parking lot, or library. Please do NOT interrupt any classes while utilizing senior privileges.
5. Seniors shall be on time for their classes. Consequences for being tardy to class, missing a mandatory class meeting, or using privileges when you do not qualify (see #2 above):
 - 1st offense = loss of senior privileges for 5 school days
 - 2nd offense = loss of senior privileges for 10 school days
 - 3rd offense = loss of senior privileges for 20 school days
 - 4th offense = loss of senior privileges for the remainder of the school year
6. Excessive or unexcused absences from class or study hall as defined in the student handbook will result in the loss of senior privileges for the remainder of the school year.
7. At the onset of senior year, anything that violates school policy and/or the law will result in the ineligibility of senior privileges. For example, underage consumption, possession of alcohol/tobacco, etc.
8. Respectful, responsible behavior and a willingness to abide by ALL school policies/personnel are a requirement. Teachers have the right to request a student's senior privileges suspended. Period of time to be determined by administration. **A student receiving suspension for any reason will have their senior privileges revoked.**
9. Administration reserves the right to revoke senior privileges for academic or disciplinary reasons including late or missing assignments, disruptive or disrespectful behavior, and refusal to wear a mask.
10. Seniors need parental permission to receive senior privileges and this contract must be signed by both the student and parent/guardian, even if the student is 18 years of age. *(Forgery below constitutes an automatic loss of senior privileges and disciplinary action will follow.)*
