Other important reminders for students and parents:

- If you or someone in your household have a COVID-19 test, you must stay home until you receive results.
- If someone in your household tests positive, you must quarantine.
- If a student is quarantined, the student should not leave home.
- If a child does not feel well, the child should not come to school. Call the school nurse and she will help decide.

Remember the safe practices for combating germs and spreading disease:

- continue to wash hands often
- use hand sanitizer when you can't wash your hands
- avoid touching your face
- wear a mask/shield
- continue to social distance when possible and avoid large gatherings
