Dear RSU 1 Staff and Families,

One Morse student, one Morse/Bath Tech student, and one preschool student in the Bath Tech program tested positive for COVID-19 over the holiday break. The students were not in school during the period of infection/transmission. Therefore, we do not need to conduct contact tracing and exclude students and staff from attending school due to these positive cases. We are notifying staff and families out of an abundance of caution.

Upon learning of the confirmed positive tests, we implemented our response protocol. We must follow privacy laws and protect the confidentiality interests of every student and staff member, while also ensuring that we are protecting the health and well-being of all members of our school community. We are committed to keeping our students and staff safe and appreciate our working relationship with the Maine Department of Education, Maine CDC, and school physician, Dr. Amina Hanna.
