Valued Shelbyville Main Street School Parents / Partners,

Today, Main Street Elementary School is experiencing an issue with the heating system. The situation is currently being diagnosed by professionals, and at this time, it does not appear the issue will be resolved before classes resume tomorrow. Due to the absence of heat within the building, the school leadership team has developed an educational plan for students in 1st-3rd grades for January 5th and possibly for multiple days. This plan is based on the generosity of two of our local churches located near Main Street Elementary. The school district is grateful to the First United Methodist Church and the First Presbyterian Church for their help during our time of need.

Students will maintain arrival & dismissal processes as usual. Bus transportation students will be dropped off on North 1st street & enter the school via the northwest doors. Students walking or dropped-off will enter the school via the south doors. All students will be temperature screened prior to entry. Students will enter the school & report to their core classroom where they will be served breakfast if they choose. Students will be escorted to their learning spaces where they will receive direct instruction. Students will also eat lunch in these church classrooms.

The Presbyterian Church just north of Main Street School where Tiny Tech is based will be used to serve all 1st grade students. The Methodist Church adjacent to Main Street School will be utilized to serve all 2nd & 3rd grade students. This plan will allow us to maintain a small campus to help with safety, logistics & convenience for families.

The Main Street Elementary School office will remain the communications hub for the school. If a student arrives late to school or if a student needs to leave school early, parents should report to the office. Students will be escorted to and from church classes in these types of situations.

Students will receive all services and specials as normal. We do encourage that students wear a warm coat for trips between the buildings and for PE. Your child's learning day will be the same as far as schedule & personnel working with them, but the location will be different. **Pre-K is not affected by this situation and will continue to take place as normal.** As situations and plans change, the school district will communicate this information to you.
