School Board Scholarship

The Andes Central School Board may annually award School Board Scholarship(s) to eligible graduating seniors.

A student is considered eligible to be considered for the School Board Scholarship if they can: identify a board member who is a biological parent, adoptive parent, step-parent, or legal guardian, and who has provided day to day care and/or financial support to them during the time the adult served on the Andes Central School Board.

The student must claim his/her scholarship award within three (3) years of graduating from Andes Central High School. If not claimed, the award money will be placed into the scholarship fund to be awarded to eligible future recipients.

Annually, the School Board members will have the opportunity to donate one or more of their meeting stipends to the Scholarship Fund.
