

To Our Students, Parents, and Manton Community:

As you have probably now heard, today the Department of Health and Human Services has decided that all high schools in Michigan will remain closed for the next 12 days. The high school will continue to learn remotely until that point. We will provide additional details to our high school students and parents in the upcoming days. The continued closure does impact athletics at all grade levels. Athletics cannot resume until the closure is lifted. We will be resuming face-to-face learning K-8 this Wednesday, December 9<sup>th</sup>. Busses will run as normal for those K-8 students in the morning. We will not resume our 1:00-2:00 intervention groups until after mid-winter assessments in early January. The reason for this is the different busses and different students they ride home with at 2:00 as compared to their normal morning and 1:00 bus, as well as the fact that some intervention groups combine students from different cohorts. In an effort to minimize contact between students who normally don't come in contact during the day, the decision was made to not conduct interventions at this time. Meals for virtual and 9-12 graders will resume this Wednesday from 3:00-4:00. Those meals can be picked up in front of the high school gym. We look forward to seeing our K-8 students this Wednesday and to continue to work with our high school students virtually. Thank you for your continued support of Manton Consolidated Schools!
