Continue to provide small group instructional support in ELA and math. After school programs for bilingual support.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Bilingual Homework Club- 25 students in attendance -EL Afterschool Club- 7 in attendance -Title 1- 63 students (1-3) & 64 students (3-5) -8:30-9:15 daily, Heidi Taylor works with small groups of students on targeted needs, rotates between grades/classes. -Kim Beard- 4th grade math support (3-7 kids daily from 9:00-9:30) -Shelly Daugherty- 5th grade math support, 3 days a week works with 15 4th graders on reading support, 5th grade ELA push in. -Native American Liaisons- push in support where needed.
