During the program students organize their own city, county, and state governments; campaign for office and hold elections; introduce and debate bills in their own legislature; establish law enforcement and court systems; publish a daily newspaper; and create radio and tv broadcasts. Guest speakers include individuals from the government, legislature, law enforcement, law, journalism, and public officials.
