Extent of the Award

By action of the Hicksville Aerie & Auxiliary F.O.E. – “For the school year 2022-2023, a chosen member, child, or spouse of a member of said Aerie or Auxiliary will be awarded a Scholarship to further his or her education.”

Objectives of the Scholarship Award

1. To provide initial or continued support to students furthering their education.
2. To reward deserving children of the F.O.E. Aerie or Auxiliary.
3. To promote the image of the Aerie and Auxiliary.
4. To help insure the Eagles & Auxiliary “service” continues into future generations.

Eligibility Requirements

NOTE: ALL PAGES MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY, TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SCHOLARSHIP.

1. Any student who is a member or whose parent, appointed guardian, or spouse is a member of the Hicksville F.O.E Aerie or Auxiliary, regardless of race, sex, or creed is eligible.
2. The student must be planning to further his/her education in a post-secondary institution of learning, and be enrolled as a full-time student. On-line schools and/or certificate programs.... Do NOT qualify.
3. The Student’s application, along with the School’s evaluation form should be forwarded to the Hicksville F.O.E. Secretary by **April 15th, 2023**. A recommendation form from a person of the student’s choosing (but not a family member) must also be forwarded by the **April 15th deadline**.
4. Selected Students “College”, of choice, will receive a check from the Hicksville F.O.E. to be used toward their education. If for any reason a selected student fails to continue to his/her education; the scholarship money must be returned and will be forwarded to an alternate.
5. Students who have won previously may reapply each year by using their post-secondary school and not their local high school, for references and recommendations **(CAN ONLY BE AWARDED A TOTAL OF 4 SCHOLARSHIPS)**.
6. Grade point average, MUST carry a minimum of a 3.0 GPA, or higher.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The following list of criteria and the assigned point values may be used by the Selection Committee to aid in the evaluation and comparison of the student's application. The intentions of the point values are to be used for comparison purposes for the committee members in formulating his/her choice of a winner or winners and an alternate winner. All final selections will be a result of a vote, by the Selection Committee and will be final.

NOTE: Please be sure to answer ALL questions. The applications are decided on the point system and if there is no answer to a question, it automatically receives zero points.

1. Participation in Eagle functions. (5 points)
2. Student participation in service activities – community, church, etc. (5 points)
3. Student's career goals (explain). (5 points)
4. School extra-curricular activities. (5 points)
5. School recommendations. (10 points)
6. Personal recommendations. (10 points)
7. Indication of need (special financial need, etc.) (20 points)
8. Grade point average (must carry 3.0 GPA or higher) (10 points) – **MUST PROVIDE COPY OF TRANSCRIPTS or print out of Current Grades**
9. What paying employment have you held? (10 points)
10. Years of being an Eagle Member or Parent/Guardian/Spouse (20 points).
1 point per year of being a Member, maximum of 20 points. 20 points to Applicant, if he/she is a current Hicksville Eagle Member.
