Lakeland Regional High School is currently planning to offer the PSAT and SAT this April to our students. In an effort to plan for testing and ensure that we can appropriately accommodate testers while maintaining social distancing, students that wish to test must register for testing by Friday, January 15, 2020 using the registration link provided at the bottom of this notification. The SAT test fee must be received by February 19th. Payments can be submitted directly to Mr. Ken McCurnin in Room 08 or in the School Counseling Office located in the West Building. All checks should be made payable to Lakeland Regional High School and should have the *student's* first and last name in the memo line.

Please remember that the PSAT and SAT are administered in accordance with guidelines established by the College Board. The PSAT and SAT must be taken at Lakeland Regional High School on the assigned testing dates. No virtual testing will be allowed. Students that wish to test with accommodations must have accommodations approved by the College Board. No exceptions can be made to these policies. The accommodation approval process can be lengthy. If a test taker wishes to test with accommodations that are not already approved by the College Board, please begin this process immediately. The deadline for students to submit requests for testing accommodations is February 22, 2021. Please visit the [College Board website](#) for additional information regarding testing accommodations.

Students Eligible for Testing	All students in 9 th and 10 th Grade All 11 th Grade students that <i>did not</i> take the PSAT in October 12 th Grade students that have not met NJDOE graduation testing requirements.
Cost	There is no cost for students to take the PSAT.
