



What do I do when my child has tested positive for COVID-19?

Step 1: Notify the school nurse of the positive result-please share the date of the positive result, the place where you tested, and if it was a rapid or PCR test. We will ask the day the child began to show symptoms, if any.

Step 2: To be sure your information is on file with the Department of Health, contact the Suffolk County Department of Health at 631-854-0000 and provide them with all of the information regarding the person who has tested positive.

Step 3: Your child is quarantined for 10 days starting from the positive test date or if they were symptomatic, 10 days from the start of symptoms.

Your child will be released from quarantine after 10 days, and symptom free for 72 hours.

Provide the school with the release from quarantine letter from the Department of Health or your healthcare provider prior to returning from school.
