- (f) Copy of state STAAR/EOC Test if the student has been in a tested grade.

AGREEMENT FOR INTER-DISTRICT STUDENT
TRANSFERS
GRADY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

Students who transfer to Grady I.S.D. while residing in other school districts are subject to certain conditions. Inter-district transfers are a privilege granted by the receiving district and are not a right of students living outside of the district. Grady I.S.D. retains the right to accept or reject any and all transfer applications based on an individual evaluation of the following:

1. Grades
2. **Attendance**
3. **Discipline infractions**
4. **Potential adverse effect of the transfer on the financial well being of the district**

Grady ISD administration screens applications for inter-district transfers. The acceptance or rejection of a student transfer shall not be made with regard to race, religion, color, sex, disability, or national origin. As part of this screening process, applicants can expect the administration to do the following:

1. Meet with the parent(s)/guardian and student regarding the potential student's school history and records; and
2. Consider heavily the potential student's grades, test scores, attendance, and discipline at his/her previous school;

Inter-district transfer students accepted and enrolled in Grady ISD are screened annually to confirm their continued eligibility for transfer status for the next school year. The transfer student's grades, attendance, and discipline referrals are the primary factors to be considered for maintaining a student's inter-district transfer. These factors may be considered at any time during the school year by Grady ISD administration, and may result in a revocation of the student's transfer status at any time during the school year.

At the discretion of Grady ISD Administration, students transfer may be revoked during the school year should any of the following situations occur:

Grades:

1. **Student fails to pass all core subjects each 6 weeks.**
2. **Student has chronic zeros and/or failing grades in any class.**

Attendance:

3. **Student fails to maintain regular attendance or have adequate documentation when absent. This regular attendance includes attendance on early release days set by the district.**

Discipline:

4. **Student has more than two (2) office referrals per school year. Referrals of a disruptive nature may result in revocation of transfer prior to two (2)**

office referrals.

5. Student engages in chronic minor violations of the Student Code of Conduct, including, but not limited to, repeated dress and grooming code violations.
6. Student engages in any single major violation of the Student Code of Conduct.
7. Student engages in any gang related activity.

Other Activity:

8. Student fails to adhere to the Grady ISD drug testing policy if student elects to participate in extracurricular activities or park a vehicle on campus.
9. Student engages in other behavior, which results in the hindering the learning process of other students.

Should any of these instances occur, the Grady ISD administration will determine, in its own discretion, the future status of the student's transfer. If the transfer is revoked, the parent and the district of the student's residence will be notified, and the student must be immediately re-enrolled in the home district or another district of the parent/guardian's choice. A revocation of a transfer shall be effective on the date of notice to the parent/guardian of the revocation. The student's revocation shall be in effect pending any dispute of such revocation.
