ROSTER: Please enter your information onto Trackwrestling by Tuesday, January 12th. You should have an access code that was sent.

FANS: Visitor fans will enter through the main entrance in the front, and home fans will enter through the back entrance.

<u>PARKING:</u> Visitor fans will park in front of the main entrance and come in the front of the school. Home fans will park behind the school and enter in the back of the school.

<u>GENERAL INFORMATION:</u> Training room facilities will be available if absolutely necessary but would prefer taping happens in the locker room or at the benches (there may not be a trainer on duty). Artificial noisemakers are prohibited. Starting lineups will be announced for varsity games. Please send pictures of your starters ASAP if possible for our videoboards. The National Anthem will be played before the girls varsity game.

CHEERLEADERS: No visiting cheerleaders allowed due to current DHM and Centennial Public School protocols.

COVID EXPECTATIONS:

- All spectators are allowed to attend no pass list needed but we will use our clickers to keep count of attendance. Our attendance capacity at 50% is 750. We safely feel that we can accommodate all fans that want to attend and stay under our 50% capacity.
- Social distancing is required
- Masks are REQUIRED by all coaches, non-participating athletes, workers at the table, and fans at all times
- Only 3 per restroom at a time




