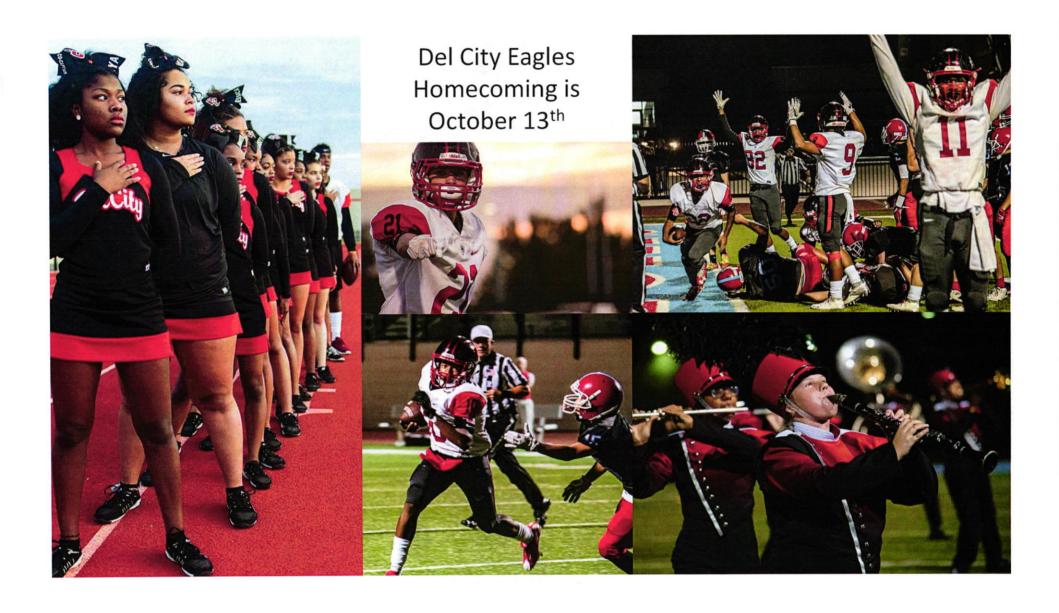

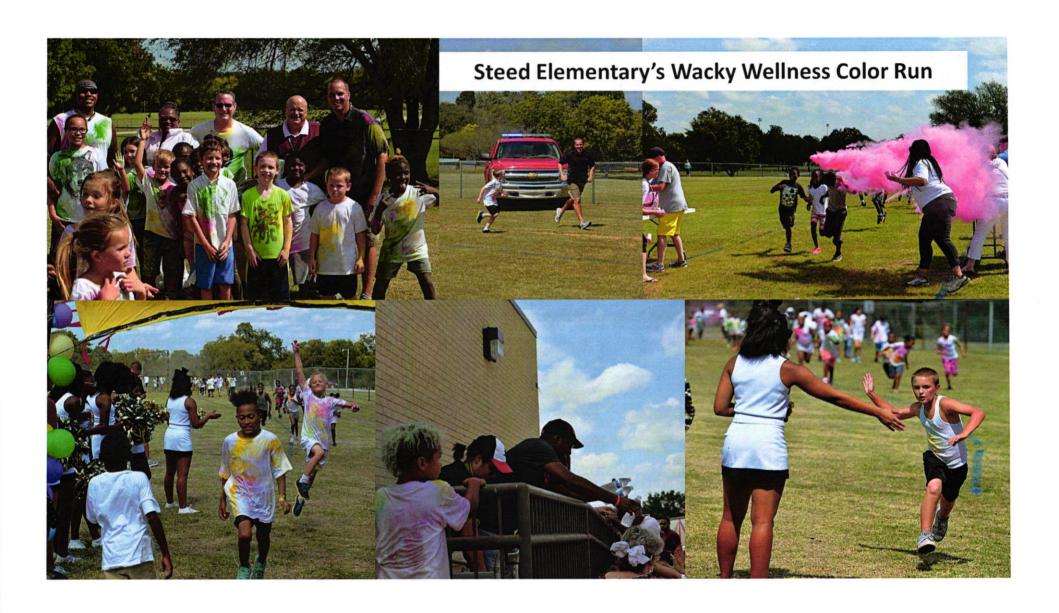


Superintendent's Report October 9, 2017
