Return to Hybrid Checklist

Health Screening:

- Complete the health screening, emailed daily, for each child enrolled in the Hybrid Model prior to boarding the bus or arriving at school.
- An answer of yes to any health screening questions requires your child to remain at home. Please call the office to notify the school of your child's absence.

Health Protocols:

- A student must stay at home if they have any COVID-19 related symptoms: feverish feeling (chills, sweating), loss or decrease of sense of smell or taste, cough, sore throat, vomiting or diarrhea, mild or moderate breathing difficulties, muscle or body aches, and/or a temperature of 100.4. Please call the school to report the absence.
- If anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, all of your children must stay home until we can verify that your child does not have COVID-19.
- If your child has been in close contact with an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 or is suspected of having COVID-19 infection, please call the office.

Social Distancing

- Students are assigned to a desk/table, 6 feet apart from other students.
- Classrooms are arranged to allow for social distancing when walking or lining up.
- Visual markers indicate social distancing in hallways, drinking fountains, restrooms, and entryways.

Face Coverings

- Face coverings must be worn at all times, even when social distancing
- Face coverings are not required outside **if** social distance is maintained
- Please send extra masks to school with your child

Drinking Fountains

• Please send a water bottle with your child, which can be filled at our hands-free filling stations.

Meals

- Any student can pick up a free breakfast/lunch combo meal as they exit the building for the day.
- Please have a conversation with your child if you wish for them to pick up meals.
