East Elementary Students are to sit with their parents or the adults they came to the game with. There is no East Elementary section.



Medications

If your student takes medication at school, we <u>MUST</u> have a medication form on file for each medication.

This form is available at the office, and in your registration packet.

Medication includes aspirin, non-aspirin products and any other overthe-counter medication, as well as prescriptions. You may send medication to school, but it must be kept

After School Pick-up Information

If you are picking up a student up after school, please follow these directions:

1. Each child will receive a dismissal number at Open House. You will need this number to pick up your child in the dismissal line. It can be displayed in the windshield of your



vehicle or passenger side front window.

- You will need to pick up your child through the circle drive (do not go to the office or park in the North parking lot). ALL students must be picked up in the circle drive.
- Line up on Normal College Avenue to enter the circle drive, this keeps the traffic flowing smoothly. Do not line up on 6th Street as this is where the buses load.
- 4. PLEASE be patient the first week of school, as it takes a few days to get the system running smoothly. After that, it will take very little time to pick up your child.

Walkers/Bikers

- All students biking to school need to park their bicycle in the racks on the South side of the building.
- Walkers and Bikers will be released from school at the end of the day
 AFTER all the buses have left.
 - Walkers and Bikers will use the crosswalk to cross East 6th Street, and use the South sidewalks to go home.
