Governor Releases Proposal for In-Person Instruction Grants

Tonight, the Governor's office released the budget trailer bill language detailing his proposal for grants to school agencies to incentivize school reopening. Because the Governor proposes using \$2 billion of 2020-21 Prop 98 General Fund, we need to see how that fits with the Governor's broader budget proposal, which will be released tomorrow.

At first look, the timelines in the bill appear challenging (reopening tiers beginning February 1). The funds are "on the table" but cannot be used on salaries for teachers not providing any in-person instruction. There are minimum grants for necessary small school districts. The grants are not available to non-classroom based charter schools.

We are in the process of analyzing the proposal further and will provide additional information tomorrow, but we want you to have the details tonight.

Keep in mind, this is a proposal from the Governor and there is no agreement yet with the Legislature, so this is subject to potentially significant change.
