John Israel Scholarship Trust Fund

The John Israel Scholarship Trust Fund has been established by Mrs. Anne Israel in memory of her late husband, John Israel. It is managed by the Blue Mountain Community Foundation (BMCF.) The fund is established to provide scholarships for individuals who have graduated from Dayton High School. This does not have to be limited to current year seniors; it can include persons who have graduated in prior years but who are continuing their education.

Selection Criteria:

- 1. Current senior or postgraduate.
- 2. <u>Must not</u> be a relative of the donor nor of members of the selection committee.
- 3. Must be a <u>full time</u> student at any accredited college or accredited vocational school.
- 4. Must attain at least average scholastic achievement.
- 5. Must demonstrate financial need.
- 6. Students may be considered for scholarship grants in any year of college.

Selection Committee:

As a means of accomplishing scholarship grants, BMCF Trustee shall delegate to the principal of Dayton High School, the manager (or designated employee) of Northwest Grain Growers (Dayton Office), and the Chairman of the Board of Columbia County Commissioners the selection of persons to receive such grants from among qualified applicants. The selection of applicants shall be recommended to BMCF Trustees for final determination and approval.

Grant Amount: The minimum grant shall be \$500.

Application Procedure:

A student interested in applying must submit the following:

- 1. Letter of application.
- 2. A resume' of activities.
- 3. A transcript of grades from the high school, college or university.
- 4. A letter of recommendation from a teacher or someone else connected with Dayton High School or the college or university being attended.
- 5. A letter of recommendation from someone not connected with Dayton High School or the college or university being attended, and not a relative.

Deadline Date:

To be considered for this grant, the application must be turned in to Jana Eaton in the Administration Office on or before, **February 26, 2021**

Payment of Scholarship:

Payment of the scholarship award will be made directly to the college or university being attended or to be attended by the recipient, for his or her account, and will be made promptly upon receipt of enrollment verification (copy of student's class registration) from the college's or university's registrar.
