REQUIREMENTS

****PLEASE NOTE: THIS IS FOR THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 2020/2021.****

- All applicants must submit a completed a FAFSA by the March 1, 2020 deadline to be eligible.
- Must complete high school graduation requirements at a West Virginia public or private high school.
- Must achieve a cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or whatever is considered a "B" average, based on county board grading policies, in both core courses AND overall coursework required for graduation by the West Virginia Department of Education.
- **Students who have not met the GPA and/ or test score requirements, can qualify after March 1, 2020. You must, however, submit an application for PROMISE and FAFSA by the March 1st deadline.**
- Applicants qualifications with be based on the seventh semester grades, the student must maintain the grade point average requirement through the eighth semester, or the scholarship will be revoked.
- Must complete the minimum core class requirements for the complete core class listing.
 - English - 4 credits
 - Mathematics - 4 credits
 - Social Sciences - 4 credits
 - Natural Sciences - 3 credits
- Must meet standardized test score criteria on ACT or SAT national test by the July test date for ACT and June test date for the SAT of the application year.
- ACT Score requirement:
 - 22 composite score with a minimum of 20 in English, Mathematics, Science, and Reading.
- SAT Score requirement:
 - Total score 1100.
 - Math 520.
 - Evidence Based Reading and Writing 530.
 - The SAT writing portion is not included in the calculation of the composite score.
- Scores must be from a single testing date and cannot be combined from multiple test administrations.
- Last test dates to qualify for PROMISE
 - ACT- July 17, 2021
 - SAT- June 5, 2021

- Please, remember that your k12 email account expires after you graduate. When filling out Scholarships, PROMISE, FAFSA or anything that will follow you after graduation, use an email that will follow you.

- Let's talk about ACT and SAT scores. I have heard many stating that the scores from one test carries over so "if I got a 24 on English on the last test but only a 19 on this testthe 24 is what goes on my college applications and PROMISE" NOT TRUE! For some college it is true like WVU and this is called

super scoring, where they take the highest English, Math, Science and Social Studies from each test you take. PLEASE BEE AWARE -----PROMISE does not super score they take the last test you take. NOT all colleges super score, check with the college you plan to attend.
