



Chromebook FAQ



How do I get my Chromebook?

- They will be passed out at each school.
- Parents and students must sign 1 to 1 policy.
- Date and time for pickup will be determined by each school .
- Students transferring in to Marion County will pick up at board office.



What do I do with the Chromebook if I leave Marion County?

- Students must return Chromebook, charger, and case to their principal.
- Graduates must return Chromebooks to their principal.
- Failure to return items could result in being charged for items.



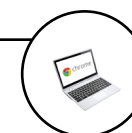
What do I do if my Chromebook has a problem?

- Broken or damaged Chromebooks should be reported to teacher or principal.
- Report stolen Chromebook to police.
- Do not take to an outside computer service for repairs or maintenance.



How should I take care of my Chromebook?

- No food or drink near them.
- Do not store or use near pets.
- No writing, drawings, or stickers on devices.
- Never place a heavy object on device.
- Never leave unsecured or loan device.



What are some rules I have to follow in the class?

- No inappropriate media.
- Sound is always down.
- Bring device fully charged, and your own headphones or earbuds to school daily.
- Printing from device is okay at home and at school.



How do I log on to the Chromebook?

- Log in using Office 365 username and password.
- Example:
jdoe@stu.k12.wvu.us
USERNAME: jdoe
PASSWORD: same as office 365 password
