The student must have at least a 2.5 GPA to be verified by North Marion administration. The monies provided must be used for educational expenses to include, but not limited to, books, tuition, fees, travel to and from school, rent while engaged in academic activity and other legitimate educational expenses. Applications will be reviewed by the Chapter 1055 Scholarship Committee and North Marion administration. Presentation of the scholarship will be made at the North Marion High School Awards Ceremony of 2020.
