


To score item level data online:



Universal Screener Directions: A Universal Screener/Baseline READING test is administered in the fall for all ELA students (grades K-8) to assist teachers in making initial small groups for intervention. This screener is the "Fall Benchmark" and consists of 3 subtests for each grade level (white boxes):

INDIVIDUAL ADMINISTRATION: (For fluency measures - All measures except Vocabulary and Comprehension)

- 1. Click on the MEASURES tab
- 2. Click the Benchmark tab.
- 3. Scroll down to click on your grade level
- Scroll down to Fall, Winter or Spring Tests

To score on paper and enter scores online:

- Download and print student copies and an assessor copy. Administer the evaluation.
