## PHASE 1A

### TIER 1

- Acute care, psychiatric and correctional facility hospitals
- Residents and staff in skilled nursing and assisted living facilities, and similar settings
- Paramedics, EMTs, and others providing emergency medical services
- Dialysis centers

### TIER 2

- Intermediate care facilities (subacute care)
- Home health care and in-home supportive services
- Community health workers, including promotoras
- Public health field staff
- Primary Care clinics

### TIER 3

- Other healthcare workers, including
- Specialty clinics
  - Laboratory workers
  - Dental / oral health clinics and pharmacy staff

## PHASE 1B

### TIER 1

- People age 75 years and older
- Frontline essential workers, including
  - Education
  - Childcare
  - Emergency services
  - Food & agriculture

### TIER 2

- People age 65 years and older
- Transportation and Logistics
- Industrial, Commercial Residential, and sheltering facilities/services
- Critical manufacturing
- Incarcerated individuals in jails and prisons
- Homeless individuals

## PHASE 1C

- Peoples age 50 years and older
- People age 16 - 49 years with underlying medical condition or disability
- Water & Waste Management
- Legal/defense
- Energy
- IT & Communications
- Financial services
- Chemicals/hazardous materials
- Government Operations and Community-based essential functions
