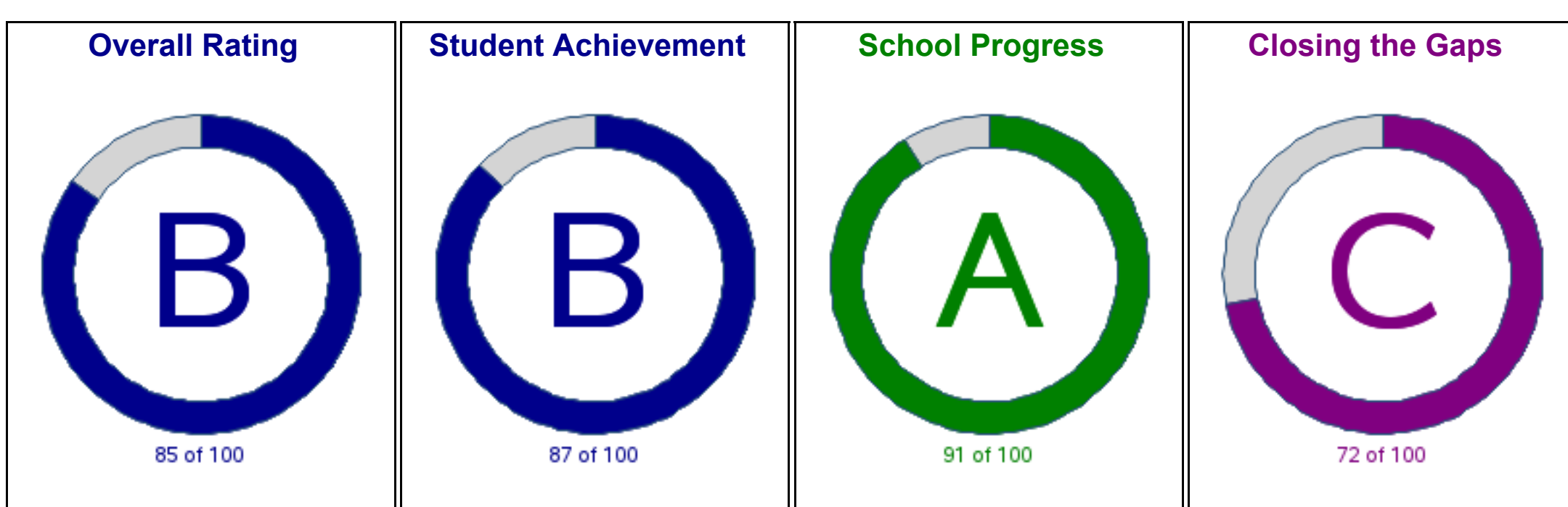

Accountability Ratings
