2021 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

- I. ELIGIBILITY TO WIN:** Any 2021 graduating high school senior who meets the following qualifications.
- A.** Parents or guardians must be members of the Tom Green County Farm Bureau.
 - B.** Applicant must be admitted to a college or university the summer or fall of 2021 and show evidence of admission.
- II. SELECTION OF WINNER BASED ON:**
- A.** Completed application form in the Tom Green County Farm Bureau office (2575 Loop 306) by March 5, 2021.
 - B.** Scholastic rank and grade point average among classmates.
 - C.** Leadership and citizenship achievements during high school years.
 - D.** Essay, submitted by the applicant, 500 words or more on: "My career goals and how I plan to achieve them."
- III. RULES**
- A.** Two 2021 scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 each will be awarded over a period of 1 year, in the amount of \$500.00 per semester.
 - B.** Each semester's \$500.00 increment will be awarded after the winner has provided the Tom Green County Farm Bureau evidence that he or she has been admitted to a college or university and will attend the current semester.
 - C.** The Tom Green County Farm Bureau reserves the right to terminate the scholarship if the winner fails to meet acceptable standards of college attendance and scholarship achievements.
 - D.** The following must be in the Tom Green County Farm Bureau's office by March 5, 2021.
 - 1. Completed application form.
 - 2. Letter of recommendation from 2020 -2021 senior class teacher indicating leadership and citizenship achievements.
 - 3. Letter from high school principal indicating scholastic rank and grade point average among classmates.
 - 4. Essay of 500 words or more, typed or legibly written.

Information regarding the 2021 Texas Farm Bureau Scholarships has been placed on the Texas Farm Bureau website.

There are several scholarship opportunities provided by Texas Farm Bureau. Three of the available scholarship programs are for high school students who have not yet graduated:

- TFB District Scholarship (52 available)
- TFB Young Farmer & Rancher High School Scholarship (13 available)
- TFB Dick Mitchell Memorial Scholarship (1 available)

The remaining three scholarships are for enrolled college students:

- TFB Young Farmer & Rancher Enrolled College Student Scholarship (3 available)
- TFB S.M. True, Jr. Agricultural Scholar Award Scholarship (1 available)
- Fall 2021 Student Teacher Scholarship (4 available)

The scholarship application process is online through a portal called MyTFB. All information for the scholarships can be found on the Texas Farm Bureau website under the Youth Opportunities page. This includes deadlines, individual scholarship rules, eligibility, awards and the link to MyTFB. All scholarship applications must be submitted online no later than midnight **March 5, 2021**.

With the exception of the S.M. True, Jr. Agricultural Scholar Award Scholarship, applicants will be notified of the results by May 3, 2021. The winner of the S. M. True, Jr. Award is announced later in May.

The scholarships listed above represent a part of the total scholarship funds offered by Texas Farm Bureau. Other scholarship programs, including the Free Enterprise Speech Contest, will be announced later. You are encouraged to make eligible students, their parents, high school counselors and your membership aware of these opportunities.
