STRIDER BIKES AT MGS

This year I wanted to upgrade my PE curriculum by providing Pre K-1st Grade students with the opportunity to learn how to ride a bike through the All Kids Bike Organization. I learned about the Grant through ΑII Kids Bike an advertisement in the mail and immediately filled out an application to get the fundraiser process started.

I went around town to local businesses and hung up signs with a QR code for community members to scan and help make a donation. I also had a website that people could go onto for donations. We quickly began getting donations and eventually met the dollar amount required to get bikes for our students at Martin Grade School!

The grant provided us with 25 Strider bikes and helmets for our students. I sought out our high school shop teacher, Rob Cotten, to help build portable bike racks that I could use for storage. Before I knew it I had the bikes neatly stored on newly built bike racks built by the high school shop classes!

I plan on teaching the 8 week bike riding curriculum this 2023 spring semester as the weather gets a bit warmer outside. The students will work on balancing and controlling their bikes the first 4 weeks of the program and then pedaling and maneuvering the last 4 weeks.

This process would not have been possible without the support of the generous donors and staff members in the Bennett County School District.

3 TO 5 YR OLD PRESCHOOL DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENING

The Bennett County School District will be hosting a 3 to 5 year old Development Screening at the Martin Grade School Little Gym, scheduled from 8:00 AM to 3:30 PM on April 12th, 2023. This is a free service to the families living in Bennett County. Areas to be screened include: motor, communication, concepts, and hearing. Screening of young children will let parents know whether their child is developing within normal range. If delays exist, it is crucial to provide intervention at the earliest possible age.

Children who will be 4 years old by September 1, 2023 may enroll in Bennett County School Preschool program. Placement for the Preschool Program will be determined according to the number of students wishing to enroll, the number of slots available, and child need.

Children who will be five by September 1, 2023 may enroll in Kindergarten at the screening.

Children enrolling in either preschool or kindergarten will need to bring to the screening: a birth certificate , immunization record, and social security number before adding to the class lists.
