Because high school sports are on pause, we will look back at previous Hornet athletes. 2014 Harvard High School graduate, Jorge Pichardo, ran track and field and cross country at Viterbo University in La Crosse, Wisconsin. He was named Viterbo's Male Athlete of The Year in May of 2019. The first-ever student-athlete from cross country to win the award. He was the fourth national qualifier in Viterbo's men's cross country history after placing third and earning all-conference honors at the Northstar Athletic Association meet in 2018. He finished off his cross country career on a high note, breaking the eight kilometer program record at the NAIA National Championship in Cedar Rapids, lowa, with a time 26 minutes, 14.1 seconds.
