WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math

 In math this week we will begin working on our last unit and solving two-step word problems, as well as reviewing multiplication and division facts and strategies to solve.

Science

This week we will begin discussing changes in an ecosystem and the causes that create those changes. We will be discuss if the changes occur naturally or are a result of living things.

Social Studies:
