Performance Goal XI: The percentage of students satisfied with the learning environment will increase from an average of 68.8% in 2017 to 95% in 2023.


Performance Goal XII: The percentage of students satisfied with the social and physical environment will increase from 72% in 2017 to 94% in 2023.

2020-2021 & 2021-2022 Awards & Accomplishments

- Scholarship money awarded to seniors totaled \$3,534,282.
- Of 173 graduates, 94 graduates received completer certificates from the Newberry County Career Center, 42 graduates earned a Newberry County Advanced Diploma, 18 graduates were named as Newberry County School District Honor Graduates, 6 graduates earned the South Carolina Academic Honors Award, 22 graduates were inducted into the National Technical Honor Society, graduates earned a total of 568 dual credit hours for transfer credit towards college degrees, 12 Palmetto Fellows recipients earned a potential scholarship total of \$350,400 towards a four year Bachelor's Degree, 52 students earned a 3.0 or better and ranked in the top 30% of their class with a potential LIFE scholarship total of \$1,040,000 towards a four year Bachelor's Degree, and 138 students met the 3.0 requirement that qualifies a student for the HOPE scholarship with a potential HOPE scholarship total of \$1,545,600 towards a four year Bachelor's Degree.
- An administrator earned his Project Based Learning Endorsement with the S.C. Department of Education in Curriculum and Instruction after completing three graduate courses with the College of Charleston.
- The golf team won the Region 4-AAA Golf Tournament. One player won Region Girls Soccer Player of the Year. Three players won All-Region. They finished 8th in the state at the State Golf Tournament.
- The softball team won the Region 4-AAA Softball Championship. Three players made the AAA All-State Softball Team. Two players made the 4A/3A North-South Softball All-Star Team. The head varsity softball coach was named Varsity Softball Coach of the Year and North-South All-Star Softball Coach
- The varsity girls' soccer team won the Region 4-AAA Girls Soccer Championship. One player won Region Player of the Year. Five players were named Region 4-AAA All-Region Girls Soccer Players. The varsity girls' soccer coach earned his 250th career win during the 2021 girls' soccer season.
- The 2020-2021 MCHS girls' soccer team earned the United Soccer Coaches Team Academic Award for exemplary performance in the classroom as a team during the 2020-2021 academic year.
- The varsity boys' soccer team won the Region 4-AAA Boys Soccer Championship.

If an individual is living with someone without a lease agreement, then a notarized written statement from the individual with whom they are living will be required (including physical address). **A post office box will not suffice for an address.** (In the case of parents that own additional property in the district the definition of Residency as defined by the Board of Trustees will apply.

- Current water bill
- Current Federal Tax Return
- Current cell phone bill
- Satellite TV/Cable bill

*Defining Residency

Each student will attend the school that serves his/her place of legal residence as determined by the district's Board of Education. The normal definition of a resident is one who occupies a dwelling within the area at issue, has a present intent to remain within that area for a period of time, and manifests the genuineness of that intent by establishing an ongoing physical presence within that area together with indicia that his presence is something other than merely transitory in nature – i.e., one's domicile.
