

## **The Pomaria Ruritan Club Scholarship Application**

*The 2023 Pomaria Ruritan Scholarship is a non-renewable one-time cash award, sent directly to the school, college or university where its recipient attends school. The scholarship is in two equal payments of \$250.00 per below. There will be up to two \$500.00 scholarships awarded (Limit 1 per applicant).*

**Application must be submitted to the guidance counselor no later than Monday, April 17, 2023**

### **Criteria:**

The \$500.00 Scholarship is awarded each year to a graduating high school senior who resides in Newberry County, South Carolina and preferably in the community of Pomaria, SC. This graduating high school senior must also graduate from one of the following schools: Mid-Carolina High School (Prosperity, SC), or recognized "home school" program in Pomaria, SC.

### **Applicants:**

- Graduate from High School
- Attend an accredited 2 or 4 year College, University, or Vocational Technical School
- Be a United States Citizen
- Have an accumulative Grade Point Average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 Scale) or 3.5 (on a 5.0 Scale)
- Be a full time resident in Newberry County of SC

### **Applicants must submit the following:**

- Completed Application
- Minimum of 2 References (as per below)
- 250-500 Word Essay stating why you should be awarded a scholarship. This should include your career goals and your interests in pursuing an advanced education
- Copy of Acceptance Letter
- Copy of up to date certified transcript from the high school you will be graduating from

### **Award of Scholarship and Payment of Scholarship:**

- A completed application with Qualifying Grade Point Average are required for consideration of the Scholarship
- Should you be awarded the \$500.00 Scholarship, the payments as follows will be made directly to the College, University, or School as follows:
  - \$250.00 First Semester with proof of enrollment
  - \$250.00 Second Semester with proof of enrollment and GPA of 2.0 or better
- Should there be excess monies—they must be returned by the School to the Pomaria Ruritan Club, Pomaria, SC
