Welcome – Mr. Cooper welcomed everyone and thanked them for attending.

Items of business:

- Open Forum No one had any items of discussion.
- February 2023 Minutes Minutes were approved.
- MCHS School Renewal Plan (Strategic Plan) Updates State law requires that every public school in SC prepare a five-year School Improvement Plan. SICs are required by law to assist in the preparation and monitoring of this plan. The Strategic Plan is prepared once every five years and updated annually, identifying school needs. We are about to enter a new 5 (five) year cycle. Over the past few years we have experienced several changes. Due to these changes we have several items that we will need to add to our School Renewal Plan. We will also add the feedback/suggestions that we received from the committee in our break-out sessions.
 - ❖ Group 1 (Lyles) Student Achievement End of Course Test Data
 - Student Achievement-Strategy A & B
 - Changes suggested: change projected baseline percentages to align with the actual data from
 the previous year; delete outdated information such as LDC/MDC; update information such
 as changing ESOL to MLP and changing Credit Recovery to Content Recovery; add new
 information such as Performance Matters.
 - ❖ Group 2 (Cooper) Student Achievement Graduation Rate
 - Student Achievement Strategy C & D
 - Changes suggested: update terminology and new systems; delete MAP; add Performance Matters; update years; add Check Point Assessments; change Credit Recovery to Content Recovery; add MODELS Academy; add Schoology.
 - ❖ Group 3 (Harmon) School Climate / Teacher Administrator Quality
 - Teacher Admin. Quality Strategy A
 - School Climate -Strategy A & B
 - Changes suggested on School Climate: under Indicators for Implementation add School Report Card, pictures from Facebook, agenda from meeting, positive postcards, teacher conferences, newsletters, ceremony at the end of the year for volunteers. Question was asked: Will survey results ever be published? Mr. Cooper answered: Survey results are published every year on the School Report Card from the State Department of Education.
 - Changes suggested on Teacher Administrator Quality: under Indicators for Implementation add SLO Professional Review, faculty meeting professional development, leadership walkthroughs, student evaluations, survey; under Person Responsible delete ABC Mentors.
 - Needs Assessment is currently being updated by the administration. We have some areas that we are good at and some areas that we can do better in. Retention and recruitment of teachers is critical. The key is to grow them and not lose them. Additional Performance Goals with additional Action Plans (Steps) will be added to the new 5 (five) year plan.
 - Goals to add:
 - Performance Goal 10: The percentage of students who graduate in four years who are college and/or career ready will increase from 68.6% in 2022 to 98% in 2027.
 - Performance Goal 11: The percentage of EL students who met progress toward proficiency target will increase from 51% in 2022 to 68.5% in 2027.

- Awards & Accomplishments/SIC Report to the Parents Another document that SIC assists with each year is the SIC Report to the Parents. This completed document is sent out by April 30th of each year. A list of Awards & Accomplishments and a drafted SIC Report to the Parents was distributed to all members of SIC in attendance.
