All seniors are to arrive no later than 7:00 a.m. Graduates will receive passes for fifteen (15) guests to attend this year's graduation ceremony at the stadium. In the event that we have inclement weather, each senior will receive passes for six (6) guests to attend the graduation ceremony in the MCHS Gym and three (3) guests to view the ceremony from the overflow area in the cafeteria. Due to fire marshal regulations, a ticket will be required for each person (allowable capacity includes infants & small children). The graduation passes will be given to seniors at graduation practice on Thursday, June 1, 2023.

The entrance gate at Lon Armstrong Stadium will be locked at 8:15 a.m.!!! If your family arrives after that, they will not be allowed to enter the stadium.

## **Graduation Attire**

Male Requirements

Dark navy or black dress slacks
(NO JEANS OR KHAKIS)

Dark navy or black SOLID tie

White dress shirt

Black dress shoes with dark socks
(NO FLIP-FLOPS)

Female Requirements
Church dress (dress should not show across front or under gown)
Black dress shoes
(NO FLIP-FLOPS)

DO NOT wear the white collar that comes with the robe.

Graduation Gown, Cap, & Tassel

(Only Newberry School District approved/issued cords and stoles may be worn.) If you have questions and/or concerns about graduation attire please see your guidance counselor.

- Cap and gown must be worn at graduation (you may not participate without them). Also, please bring your cap/gown to practice, or you will not be included in the class picture.
- No decorations of any kind will be allowed on cap or gown.
- Failure to meet dress code/graduation attire requirements will result in the student being denied the opportunity to walk!
- No gum will be allowed during graduation.
- You MUST attend practice in order to participate in the ceremony.
