Extended Semester Guidelines and Contract

Academic Expectations and Attendance

Mid Carolina High School will be offering the Extended Semester program during the summer of 2023. Students who fail a course (English or Math) with an average of 55 – 59 will be scheduled for a session from June 5th – June 15th. Students who fail a course (English or math) with an average of 50 -54 will be scheduled for a session from June 5th – June 29th. The program will run Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. (first session), and from 10:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m. (second session). Transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Attendance until completion of the student's course is mandatory; absences will result in failure of the program. Students who are in Extended Semester will be using APEX Learning. Students will be assigned a list of essential lessons for the course they failed. Once each of these lessons has been successfully completed, the student will receive his/her unit for that course and a passing grade of 60. Students who are dismissed from the program or are unsuccessful in completing the program will be required to repeat the failed course during the regular school year. There will be no make-up days for this program. All grades are final at the conclusion of the Extended Semester Program.

Behavioral Expectations

Students will follow the behavior code as outlined by the School District of Newberry County and the Mid Carolina High School handbook. Failure to comply with these expectations could result in dismissal from the program.

Students will be required to sign in upon arrival and sign out upon dismissal each day.

It is expected that parents/guardians discuss academic expectations, attendance and behavioral guidelines with their children. The guidelines will be enforced. Your signature and that of your child will indicate that you understand the Extended Semester program expectations. Return this form to me on or before June 1, 2023. Without this form, the student will not be admitted into the program.
