WHO RECEIVES INTERVENTIONS?

Reading intervention

Students scoring at or below 35th percentile on NWEA Reading MAP AND one or more of the following:

Basic or Limited on Ohio's State Test Reading level designated by Benchmark Assessment as "Needs Short-Term Intervention"
OR...

Students on RIMP from previous year AND...Reading level designated by Benchmark Assessment as "Needs Intensive Intervention"

Math interventions

Students scoring at or below 35th percentile on NWEA Math MAP AND...
Basic or Limited on Ohio's State Test

Behavior interventions

Offered on an as needed basis

GEVSD offers a Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS).

It's a comprehensive, collaborative problem-solving process, that is proactive, unified, and data driven to meet the needs of, and improve results for all students. It involves scientifically based instruction, intervention, and assessment.

Tiered levels of prevention

Tier 1 - 80% of students

- All students within the general education classrooms receive core instruction.

Tier 2 - 15-20% of students

- Students identified as not performing on grade level.

Tier 3 - 1-5% of students

- Students not responding to Tier 2 intervention.
- Parents are invited to Tier 3 meetings.

WHEN ARE INTERVENTIONS OFFERED?

Elementary

During each grade level WISE Time (aka intervention time) 4 days a week.

Jr. High

During advisory and elective the last two periods of the day.

High School

During advisory.
