



remote/hybrid learning may be particularly difficult. <u>Click here</u> for useful tips and strategies to support students' learning and overall wellness.



What Sora is:

 An app where you can read library books on any device (ebooks, audiobooks, graphic novels, etc.)

Log in:

- 1. Go to ClassLink (under madisonnjps.org bookmarks).
- 2. Sign in with Google.
- 3. Click on the Overdrive (Sora) icon (pictured above).

Add more Libraries (New Jersey Schools Shared Collection & eLibrary NJ:

- Click the down arrow next to Madison Public Schools
- · Search for the collection and click "This is my school."
- Browse and search all collections for thousands of books!

Browse and check out books:

- Browse by: available now, popular subjects, new additions, most popular, etc., or search multiple libraries
- Click on a book. Read a sample, borrow the book, or put it on hold (if it is currently being read by another student).
- Books remain on your device for 2 weeks, or you can return them when you are done.

Access Sora from any device:

- Download the Sora app. Enter the code mpsnj.
- Select "sign in with Google" and enter your email address & password.
