CELL PHONES AND OTHER WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICES

HB 1092 allows school districts to set their own policy concerning cellular phones and other wireless devices. This policy is required but may be adjusted to an individual school district. Will Rogers Junior High will adhere to the following rules:

- Students <u>WILL NOT</u> be allowed to use their phones or other wireless communication devices during school hours unless given special permission.
- Cell phones and other wireless communication devices <u>WILL</u> be powered off during school hours and stored in lockers.
- Students <u>WILL NOT</u> be permitted to communicate via Smart Watches or similar technological devices.
- Students will report to a nurse, administrator, counselor, or front office personnel, and they will assist them appropriately in case of emergency, illness, or other communication needs.
- Headphones, Airpods and earbuds <u>ARE NOT</u> allowed to be worn or displayed during school unless used for educational purposes as directed by the teacher.
- iPod, MP3 and other personal entertainment devices are prohibited on school grounds during instructional hours. No exceptions
- Under no circumstances (unless instructed by a staff member) is photographing or audio/video recording allowed by students anywhere on the school premises; violators will face disciplinary action.

Device Infraction	<u>Consequences</u>
1st Infraction	Electronic devices are confiscated, and a parent is contacted. The device will be given back at the end of the day.
2nd Infraction	The device is confiscated, lunch detention is assigned, and the parent must pick up the device
3rd Infraction	The device is confiscated, after-school detention is assigned, and the parent must pick up the device.
4th Infraction	Device confiscated. Loss of Electronic Device Privileges being brought to school for the rest of the year. Students will be given ISR, and a parent must pick up the device.

^{**} All devices will be confiscated until the end of the instructional school day**
