Bus Safety Rules

INTRODUCTION:

CPS is committed to transporting its students to and from home in the safest and most efficient way possible. CPS wants to serve you and your students by meeting your transportation needs, but the transporting of students is a privilege and not a right, therefore:

PROCEDURES:

For the safety of all students, the bus driver will review rules with students at the beginning of the school year. Additionally, these guidelines are available for reference on the Transportation page website.

BUS SAFETY RULES:

- Students will comply with the driver's direction/instructions.
- Students are to face forward in their seats and keep all body parts inside the aisle.
- Students will conduct themselves in a proper manner for the safety of all on board.
- Students should avoid distracting the driver unless there is an emergency.
- Students should carry only items that can be secured in their laps.
- Students should not change from one seat to another while the bus is in motion.
- Drivers may assign seats.
- Students may only ride their assigned bus.
- Vandalism and the cost of damages will be the responsibility of the student.
- Food, drinks, and candy are not allowed to be consumed on the bus. Items must be stored in a backpack such as lunch or water bottle.

BUS STOP LOCATIONS:

Students should be visible 5 minutes prior to bus arrival at the designated stop location.

LOADING PROCEDURES:

Students at a stop should walk 10 feet to the front corner of the bus and look both ways. WAIT for the driver to motion student(s) across the street.

EXAMPLES OF SERIOUS MISCONDUCT RESULTING IN IMMEDIATE BUS SUSPENSION

Fighting, Damaging Property, Throwing of Objects, Threatening Behavior,
Profanity, Any Act Deemed to Compromise Safety

ANY ACT OR BEHAVIOR, SUCH AS THROWING OBJECTS, ON THE BUS, CAUSING DANGER FOR ALL ON BOARD, WILL RESULT IN SUSPENSION FROM ALL BUS TRANSPORTATION FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SCHOOL YEAR.
