

Floriculture: This course focuses on floral design and the history of the flower industry using locally grown and in season flowers and foliage. Units include introduction to the floral industry, basic botany, floral supplies and equipment, principles of floral design, color and symmetry, construction and mechanics of floral design, selection and judging, floral crops, preparation and care of flowers and foliage.

Greenhouse & Plant Production provides instruction in greenhouse structures and greenhouse environment regulations. Plant growth and development and propagation are included as well as production and maintenance of bedding and container produced plants. Fundamental principles of vegetable production and commercial production of vegetable crops is included as well as hydroponic, vertical crop production and controlled environment agriculture food production.
