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COMMUNITY

West Liberty-Salem Local Schools is located between Urbana and Bellefontaine on U.S. Highway 68. The school is conveniently located within an hour of major metropolitan areas of Springfield, Dayton, and Columbus. Landmarks in the area include Piatt and Mac-O-Chee Castles, The Ohio Caverns, and Mad River Mountain Ski Resort. A large percentage of the community is devoted to farming; however, nearby factories include Honda and Navistar as well as Honda suppliers. Families attend churches of various faiths, with the Mennonite faith representing the majority of the local churches.

SCHOOL

West Liberty-Salem currently has 1,143 students in the district. Of those, 377 are high school (grades 9-12). The district had 79% of students score at least proficient with over 42% scoring in the accelerated or advanced ranges. This represents the overall high achievement of the students within our district. Our students have continued to demonstrate high performance levels despite lingering challenges from the impacts of COVID.
