We are preparing for our students to participate in state assessments later this month. Below you will find information about High School testing calendars. Please read over this information carefully. Testing will impact ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS due to modifications to our schedule.

#### HIGH SCHOOL TESTING INFORMATION

High school students will take end-of-course assessments for specific courses. Depending on the courses that a student is enrolled in, some students will be taking more assessments than others. All of these assessments are required and the points that students earn on these assessments count towards the new Ohio Graduation Requirement. All high school end-of-course assessments are computer-based and completed on student iPads.

- \* Students need to make sure that iPads and keyboards are fully charged each day.
- Optional: drink (with lid), book to read if finished early.
- Students can bring their own calculators and wired headphones (wireless are not permitted). Extra calculators will be provided for the days of the math test as well as will packaged wired headphones.
- Students need to bring a pencil. Scrap paper will be provided.

# Week of April 17 - 21

- Students in English 10, Biology and American Government will take their end-of-course exam on Thursday, April 20th and Friday, April 21st. The entire high school will then follow a 2-hour delay schedule after testing. Those very few students not testing need to report to school by the start of first period at 9:40 on these two days. Non-tested students who ride the bus or are dropped off at the normal time will report to study hall.
- Freshmen in Physical Science will have planned activities the mornings of April 20 and 21, starting at 7:40am.
