

Proposed Changes to GPA  
February 15, 2017

1. Beginning in 2016-2017, weight all foreign language courses and AP advanced, core courses offered on ACCESS Distance Learning in GPA for all students.

*(Principals have discretion on whether or not students may take these courses if these courses are offered on their campus face-to-face.)*

2. The Class of 2017 may receive the Honors Seal if meeting the requirements. Add Graduates with Distinction for the Class of 2017. For the Class of 2017, students must pass **two AP advanced, core courses** or **two dual enrollment advanced, core courses**. For the Class of 2018 and thereafter, the requirement will be **three or more AP or DE advanced, core courses**.

The suggestion for Graduates with Distinction is a cord or medallion.

3. Keep the Honors Seal and Graduates of Distinction for the Class of 2018 (current 10<sup>th</sup>). Thereafter, the Honors Seal will no longer be an option.

4. Beginning with all students in 2016-2017, weight AP advanced, core courses and dual enrollment advanced, core courses as 1.2. Honors courses and Pre-AP courses will be weighted at 1.15.

I concur with these changes.

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
