2. The Class of 2017 may receive the Honors Seal if meeting the requirements. Add Graduates with Distinction for the Class of 2017. For the Class of 2017, students must pass two AP advanced, core courses or two dual enrollment advanced, core courses. For the Class of 2018 and thereafter, the requirement will be three or more AP or DE advanced, core courses.

The suggestion for Graduates with Distinction is a cord or medallion.

3. Keep the Honors Seal and Graduates of Distinction for the Class of 2018 (current 10th). Thereafter, the Honors Seal will no longer be an option.

4. Beginning with <u>all students in 2016-2017</u>, weight AP advanced, core courses and dual enrollment advanced, core courses as 1.2. Honors courses and Pre-AP courses will be weighted at 1.15.
