- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 a.m. by President, Monty Breneman.
- 2. Motion by David Bell, seconded by Jeana Eckhart, to adopt the agenda. Aye-6 No-0
- 3. Discussion took place on the QZAB funds as it pertains to the roof at the Lincoln Jr./Sr. High School. A conference call initiated by Mitch Walter, Gilmore and Bell, was held on Monday, September 18, 2017, at the Board of Education Office with Kathy Robertson, Joe Biggs, Mitch Obermueller, and Greta Obermueller. The purpose of the call was to move forward with acquisition of QZAB funds, discussing requirements and details involved. Mrs. Robertson received a phone call late September 19, 2017, informing her that 10 percent of net present value of QZAB monies needs to be "in kind contributions". A list was comprised by USD 298 staff of these in kind contributions. After reviewing the list, Mr. Walter felt if we are audited the district may run the risk of being forced to repay QZAB monies as these donations may not qualify as meeting the definition. The bond option is not feasible due to time restraints of getting the down payment to Geisler Roofing for materials by Friday. Capital Outlay funds were once again reviewed and possibly a split of Capital Outlay monies and entering into a lease purchase with a bank may be the only option at this time. Time is of the essence if a roof is going to be started this fall. Monty Breneman stated that none of the board members like paying interest which they would be doing in a lease agreement but in light of the time frame, the previous bond not passing and QZAB funds not being as appealing as they once were, there may be no choice if a roof is going to be put on yet this fall.
